

Special White League Rules – Fall 2019

White League amendments to Club Rules:

1. Club Rule III. LENGTH OF GAMES

A game that ends in a tie after regulation play will result in each team being awarded one (1) point.

2. Club Rule IV. COURTESY RUNNERS

If a courtesy runner is on base and is due to bat, he/she is out at the base and comes in to bat for him/her self. If it is the third out, this batter is the lead-off batter at the next inning.

3. Club Rule V. PLAYER SUBSTITUTIONS, D.

A substitute player for a game will be chosen with the same, or higher, numerical rating as the missing player. If necessary, a substitute player may be no more than a .1 rating number lower than the player being substituted for. As an example, a player with a 2.8 rating number will be substituted with another player of a 2.8, or higher, rating number. However, if necessary the substitute player may be a 2.7 rating number.

If a player is injured during a game and cannot return to play, an alternate White League (or White League Sub) player from the stands can be used to replace the injured player. Ideally, the alternate player should have a similar rating as that of the injured player leaving the game. Both game managers and a commissioner(s) shall approve the selection of the alternate player.
