## Special White League Rules Winter 2022

White League additions to Club Rules: 1. Club Rule IV. COURTESY RUNNERS

If a courtesy runner is on base and is due to bat, he/she is out at the base and comes in to bat for him/her self. If it is the third out, this batter is the lead-off batter at the next inning.

2. Club Rule V. PLAYER SUBSTITUTIONS, D.

A substitute player for a game will be chosen with the same, or higher numerical rating as the missing player. If necessary, a substitute player may be no more than a .1 rating number lower than the player being substituted for. As an example, a player with a 2.8 rating number will be substituted with another player of a 2.8, or higher, rating number. However, if necessary the substitute player may be a 2.7 rating number.

Once a substitute player has been requested and the substitute player has been contacted and has confirmed to play, the substitute player shall play in the game regardless of the team player's change of plans.

3. Club Rule XV. Ground Rules, E., Home Runs

Each team is allowed one homerun per game until the opposing team hits a homerun. If the team that first hits a homerun subsequently hits another homerun before their opponent hits a home run, it will be a walk.
